Jacob's House is an orphanage located in Pyeongtaek, South Korea. Established in 1985, the orphanage provides care for infants and toddlers.

The Republic of Korea Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated has been visiting the orphanage since 2014. The personnel at Jacob's House thoroughly enjoy members of our chapter visiting the children. Members visit the orphanage once a month. To date, members visit the orphanage for one hour, normally on the first Saturday of each month.

During the visit, members may be asked to assist the caretakers with the children. Responsibilities may include playing with infants and toddlers, helping with feeding, or engaging in speaking and interacting with the toddlers.
